- . Parents should seek permission at the school office to meet a student or staff for genuine reason.
- . Boys should have close cut hair style; girls should not have streaked hair and fancy hair style. Hair should be plaited.
- . Girls are not allowed to paint nails or merchandise.
- . To imbibe the time management skills, it's important that the pupils/ students are taught to be punctual. Ensure to adhere to the school arrival, which is 7:30am and dispersal timing which is 4:30pm; but staff will wait at the waiting room till 5:00pm for late pick up. Please do not exceed the time.
